*The winner of the rifle drawing at Newk's on August 26, 2017, was Jeff Graham.

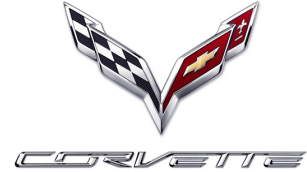
*Mark has donated the cabinet for the drawing at the Christmas party. Tickets \$20

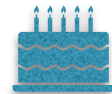

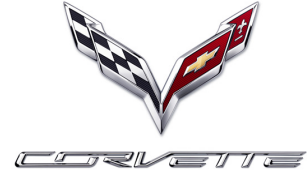
