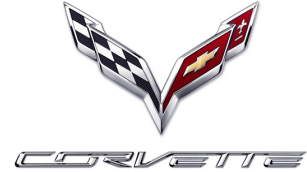
*Brian said we need to plan and make a road trip up to the NCM soon. We need to keep supporting the Corvette museum. They will also give the club personal tours.

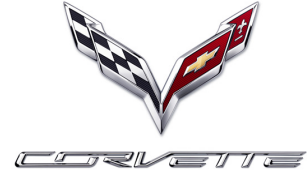
