Minutes of the Monthly Meeting for Tuesday, November 2, 2021

The November meeting was held at Chappy's Deli in Montgomery. David Dodd, President/Board Member, called the meeting to order at 6:45 pm with 48 members in attendance.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

Bo Marlin, Secretary/Board Member, stated that the minutes of the October 12, 2021, meeting were completed, approved by the Board Members, and emailed to all members for review (as well as being posted to the CCCC website). One change to the minutes was recommended—Mike & Cindy Peavy took delivery of one of their C8s on Oct 16th, but the C8R will be delivered later. The minutes were approved as amended by the members present.

TREASURER'S REPORT:
