Minutes of the Monthly Meeting for Tuesday, January 4, 2022

The January meeting was held at Chappy's Deli in Montgomery. David Dodd, President/Board Member, called the meeting to order at 6:50 pm with 35 members in attendance.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

Bo Marlin, Secretary/Board Member, stated that the minutes of the November 2, 2021, meeting were completed, approved by the Board Members, and emailed to all members for review (as well as being posted to the CCCC website). The minutes were approved as written by the members present.
